NOTICE AND SUMMONS is given that a petition has been filed in the Circuit Court for Columbia County by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbia County, Oregon. The Case Number is 08-2843. The petition was filed under authority of ORS 33.710 to 33.720.

The purpose of the petition is to request the Court to conduct a judicial examination and issue its judgment as to the regularity, legality, validity and effect of a proposed

1 Ordinance Regulating the Employment of Unauthorized Aliens identified as Ordinance No.
2 2008-6. The proposed ordinance will implement Measure 5-190, which was passed by the
3 electors of Columbia County at the general election held on November 4, 2008, while
4 correcting several inadvertent drafting errors and legal problems in the Measure.

5 Notice is further given that this Notice and Summons will be published once a week
6 for three (3) successive weeks on November 19, November 26 and December 3, 2008, in
7 *The Chronicle*, a newspaper of general circulation in Columbia County, and that jurisdiction
8 of the Circuit Court shall be established over the County, the electors, freeholders,
9 taxpayers and other interested persons without naming them individually within ten (10)
10 days after the final date of publication of this Notice and Summons.

11 Notice is further given that any interested person may, at any time before the
12 expiration of the ten (10) day period after final publication of the Notice and Summons,
13 appear and contest the regularity, legality, validity and effect of proposed Ordinance No.
14 2008-6 by the filing of an answer to the Petition with the Trial Court Clerk, Columbia County
15 Courthouse, 230 Strand, St. Helens, Oregon 97051, in the form required by law.

16 This Notice and Summons is given and published pursuant to an Order of the
17 Honorable Ted Grove, Judge of the Circuit Court, dated the 12th day of November, 2008.
