


NOTICE OF MEASURE ELECTION AND RECEIPT OF BALLOT TITLE-AMENDED

Notice is hereby given that a ballot title for a measure referred by Vernonia Rural Fire Protection District has been filed with the Columbia County Clerk on March 18, 2015.

The ballot title caption is **Five Year Local Option Levy for Emergency Services Training and Operations.**

Shall the District levy taxes of \$0.32 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five years beginning 2015-2016 for training & operations? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent and will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.			
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect			
If approved, this measure would provide funding to the Fire District, for the salary and benefits package of a Training Captain. This person would be responsible for the training program from its infancy to long term maintenance. Duties of the Training Captain would include but not be limited to: Preparing and maintaining a training calendar, preparing and maintaining personnel training files, working with the Oregon Department of Public Safety Standard and Training, assembling drills and training materials, and organizing outside training to keep all staff certified and current. The Training Captain would also be required to respond to incidents during their work shift when applicable, thereby increasing daytime response personnel. This measure is estimated to cost taxpayers an average of \$0.32 per thousand of assessed value each year. For the owner of a home or property owner, the estimated annual average cost would be \$32 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. The levy would raise approximately \$65,294 in fiscal year 2015-16; \$66,926 in 2016-17; \$68,599 in 2017-18; \$70,314 in 2018-19; and \$72,072 in 2019-20.
