The Transfer Station is closed Sundays and the following Holidays:

New Years Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

The Transfer Station may close at or after 1 PM on the following days:

Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Christmas Eve and New Years Eve.

The Transfer Station also offers a free recycling drop off depot and free household hazardous waste collection events.

You can drop for FREE recycling of glass, plastic bottles #1- #7, plastic milk jugs, newspaper, corrugated cardboard, mixed paper, magazines, scrap metal, aluminum/tin cans, motor oil, car batteries, electronic waste.

Recyclable items that may require a small fee for recycling include antifreeze, tires, fluorescent lights and appliances.

The Transfer Station holds several FREE household hazardous waste collection events each year. For a schedule of events click on the [Solid Waste Program](#) page and then on the "Household Hazardous Waste" link. Items accepted include oil based paints and stains, thinners and solvents, pool and spa chemicals, fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides, poisons, household cleaners and disinfectants, batteries, art and hobby chemicals, aerosol spray products, propane tanks or bottles from barbecue grills, unbroken fluorescent lamps and ballasts (removed from fixture), items containing mercury, small arms ammunition and medical sharps.

Garbage/Trash is accepted at the Transfer Station during open hours. Rates are determined by a per ton rate. Please call to get prices for garbage disposal.

Clatskanie Sanitary Service Drop Off:

Hours of Operations: Drop Boxes are available all hours of the day and night.

Located in the Clatskanie City Park, near the Pool, are two drop off containers. There is one container for mixed glass, the other is for mixed paper (magazines, newsprint, paper, phone books, etc.)

This location does not accept garbage/trash.

Vernonia Transfer Station:

Location: Near Anderson Park, off California Avenue

Days Open: The 2nd and 4th Saturdays of each month

Hours of Operations: 10 AM - 4 PM

The transfer station accepts the following for free: Co-mingled Recycling (Plastic bottles #1- #7, plastic milk jugs, newspaper, magazines, office paper, corrugated cardboard, magazines, aluminum/tin cans), scrap metal, clear and colored glass, motor oil (in a sealed, leak proof container), batteries, electronic waste. Recyclable items that require a small fee for recycling include tires, car batteries and appliances.

The Vernonia Transfer Station DOES NOT accept Propane or other fuel tanks, glass cookware, light bulbs/tubes, window glass, mirrors or CFC appliances.

Garbage/trash is accepted at the Vernonia Transfer Station. Rates are charged by the cubic yard. Please call for garbage rate information.
